

**Charge**

The Publications Committee (PC) is responsible for the editorial quality and performance of FASEB's publications.

**Objectives**

1. Provide editorial guidance for developing the vision for FASEB's publications including input on potential new products, programs, or services, new partnerships, and new strategic directions.
2. Work closely with the Publications staff and Editors-in-Chief on long-term, innovative strategic and scenario planning.
3. Advise FASEB Publications staff on ethical and legal issues developing in the industry and serve as a resource for Publications staff and Editors-in-Chief.
4. Review, interpret, and report on publications performance metrics semi-annually. Monitor the longitudinal editorial performance of FASEB's publications to ensure they meet the needs of FASEB and are advancing science.
5. Regularly review existing publication policies, develop, and recommend new policies to meet the changing environment, and support efforts at improving research integrity.
6. Recommend the appointment of Editors-in-Chief including appointing or serving on an Editor-in-Chief search.

**Committee members will be selected from:**

- Up to 5 regular members (active members of FASEB member societies)
- Up to 2 Early-career researchers with an interest in FASEB society publications program
- Up to 2 additional representatives with relevant subject matter expertise may be identified and recommended by the Chair in consultation with the staff liaison and appointed by the President

**Non-voting:**

- Staff Liaison: FASEB Chief Publications Officer
- FASEB Executive Director & CEO
- Additional FASEB Publications staff as identified by the Chief Publications Officer

The Federation Board seeks members with broad experience and interest in publications editorial matters who support FASEB's publications program. The Chair and Vice-Chair will be selected from the committee membership.

### **Membership Terms**

All members serve terms up to three (3) years beginning on July 1 of the year appointed and ending on June 30 of the third year. Members can be reappointed for one additional consecutive three (3) year term.

The Chair and Vice-Chair serve a minimum of one year. Both Chair and Vice-Chair terms are renewable by agreement of the Chair and Vice-Chair and the FASEB Board of Directors.
