

CHARGE

To govern, promote, and conserve Federation membership.

OBJECTIVES

1. Develop membership criteria based on the findings of the Membership Strategy Task Force.
2. Develop and implement a proactive approach to grow the Federation.
3. Review applications for Federation membership.
4. Address issues of membership retention.

MEMBERSHIP

Voting members:

- Chair: President-Elect
- Vice Chair (elected from currently serving members)
- Member (current or past within last two years), Board of Directors (3-4)
- Executive Officer (1-2)

Non-voting members:

- Treasurer
- Federation Secretary
- FASEB Director of Public Affairs

MEMBERSHIP TERMS

The Chair shall serve for the duration of their President-Elect term of office as defined by the bylaws. The Vice-Chair shall serve a one-year term beginning on July 1 and ending on June 30 of the following year. Members serve a two-year term beginning on July 1 and ending on June 30 of the second year. Members can be reappointed for one additional consecutive two (2) year term with eligibility for further reappointment after a one-year lapse.

MEMBERSHIP SELECTION

The FASEB Board seeks members with a demonstrated understanding and commitment to the Federation's strategic mission and priorities, and a willingness to serve as an ambassador to promote Federation membership.

Biographic, demographic, and scientific diversity in governance is an overarching goal of the Federation, and the Board seeks to appoint members to Federation committees who represent this diversity.
